- 3) **Update from Max Foster, BSRB Executive Director.** The following topics were discussed:
 - a. Legislative Updates.
 - b. Governor signed budget bill. BSRB budgets for the next few years were not cut.
 - c. BSRB staff are now writing the proposed regulations that will eventually lead to a reduction in the licensure fees and removal of the original license and original license fee.
 - d. BSRB staff workload is extremely busy with a significant number of transcripts, applications, renewals, and phone calls.
- 4) **Application Review.** The following topics were discussed:
 - a. In the interim, Leslie has been reviewing new Applications for LCPC Board-Approved Clinical Supervisor.
 - b. Campuses that plan to offer clinical supervision courses for LPCs was discussed.
 - c. An application needs to be developed for those who wish to offer clinical supervision courses for LPCs.
 - d. The Legislative Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and Regulations suggested that the LPC proposed permanent regulations include “hands on practice in supervision consisting of at least eight hours”.
