The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you that effective July 1, 2017 any Licensed Clinical Marriage and Family Therapist (LCMFT) who is providing postgraduate clinical supervision to a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT) working under a pre-approved clinical training plan must be a board approved clinical supervisor.

Please use the links below to find the instructions for becoming an approved supervisor, the application that must be completed, as well as the regulation that identifies the training requirements. Please note there is no additional fee associated with the process to become a board approved clinical supervisor.


Also, these requirements will be in effect for all new clinical training plans. Previously approved clinical training plans are exempt from the new requirement.
