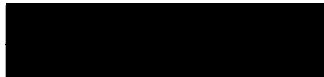

Dear Ms. Ndhlovu:

This office represents the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board. The Complaint Review Committee met to review the above complaint against you. The Board found probable cause of violations of KSA 65-6311 and KAR 102-2-7(II) and (i) for reporting erroneous or misleading social work information and failing to cooperate with the Board's investigation in a timely manner.

The Committee has determined the appropriate sanction to be a formal censure pursuant to KSA 65-6311 rather than a formal disciplinary hearing. You should consider this letter to be the formal censure. This sanction does not affect your ability to continue to practice social work. You have the right to appeal this decision by requesting a formal disciplinary hearing. Your written request for hearing must be received in the Board office, 712 South Kansas Avenue, Topeka, KS 66603 within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
