Dear Ms. Howard:

This office represents the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board. The Complaint Review Committee met to review the above self-reported complaint of practicing marriage and family therapy without a current license for a year following its expiration November 30, 2006. The Board found probable cause of violations of KSA 65-6403 and KAR 102-5-12(b) (unprofessional conduct) (51) practicing marriage and family therapy after one's license expires and (52) after a license has expired, using or continuing to use any title or abbreviation prescribed by law to be used by persons who currently hold a type or class of license.

The Committee has determined the appropriate sanction to be a formal censure pursuant to KSA 65-6408. You should consider this letter to be the formal censure. This sanction does not affect your ability to continue to practice marriage and family therapy. You have the right to appeal this decision by requesting a formal disciplinary hearing. Your written request for hearing must be received in the Board office, 712 South Kansas Avenue, Topeka, KS 66603 within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
