***ASPPB CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS FOR
THE EPPP COLLABORATIVE IMPLEMENTATION TASK FORCE (EPPP CITF)***

The Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB) is seeking individuals to serve on the EPPP CITF.

The EPPP CITF will consist of fourteen members, including delegate members (current members of a state or provincial regulatory body), ASPPB liaisons, the Chairs of the two EPPP Examination Committees, and the ASPPB Board Member in the Exam Track for 2025. The Chair and Co-Chair will be the 2025 ASPPB Board Member President-Elect and the ASPPB Associate Executive Officer-Examination Services.

The charges for the EPPP CITF are as follows:

- The EPPP CITF will gather jurisdictional and other stakeholder input and feedback on the implementation of a reimagined EPPP as an integrated competency-based exam (i.e., inclusive of knowledge and skills). This will include activities such as supplemental surveys, town halls, and focus groups.
- The EPPP CITF will advise the ASPPB Board of Directors on key considerations surrounding the successful implementation of a competency-based exam at the jurisdictional level.
- The EPPP CITF will advise the ASPPB Board of Directors on communications to jurisdictions and stakeholders.
- The charges of this Task Force do not include technical exam development activities.

Through this call for volunteers, we are seeking individuals who are current members of state or provincial regulatory bodies and individuals who are current liaisons with ASPPB.

The EPPP CITF will meet monthly for two-hour meetings (virtually), with the possibility of one two-day in-person meeting at the ASPPB home office in Tyrone, Georgia. This first scheduled virtual meeting will be held the week of January 27, 2025.

ASPPB will reimburse your travel expenses related to the in-person meeting subject to the Association's established reimbursement policies.
