# 2025 Survey of Licensees

Following previous surveys of social workers in 2021 and 2024, with the assistance of the Advisory Committees, the BSRB designed surveys for licensees in the six other professions regulated by the Board.

The survey questions focused on topics relevant to the public protection work of the Board and to better understand the workforce in Kansas.

# 2025 Survey of Licensees

While the survey included a few unique questions per profession, efforts were made to create uniformity for most topics between the professions, so both a profession-specific report and an overall summary report comparing professions could be created.

Licensees were informed that the survey was optional, though they were encouraged to participate; it would be through [surveymonkey.com](https://www.surveymonkey.com); that their responses would be anonymous; and that a report summarizing the results of the survey would be posted to the BSRB website at [bsrb.ks.gov](https://bsrb.ks.gov)

# Draft Survey Reports

Draft survey reports were presented by the BSRB Executive Director to the Advisory Committees which met in April 2025. These draft reports are currently available on the BSRB website under the materials for the following meetings:

# Survey Response Rates

The response rates for the survey are detailed below:

- Licensed Psychology
  - LPs - 297 licensees completed the survey (28.4%)
- Marriage and Family Therapy
  - Overall – 296 licensees completed the survey (25.0%)
  - LMFTs – 69 licensees completed the survey (22.6%)
  - LCMFTs – 227 licensees completed the survey (25.9%)

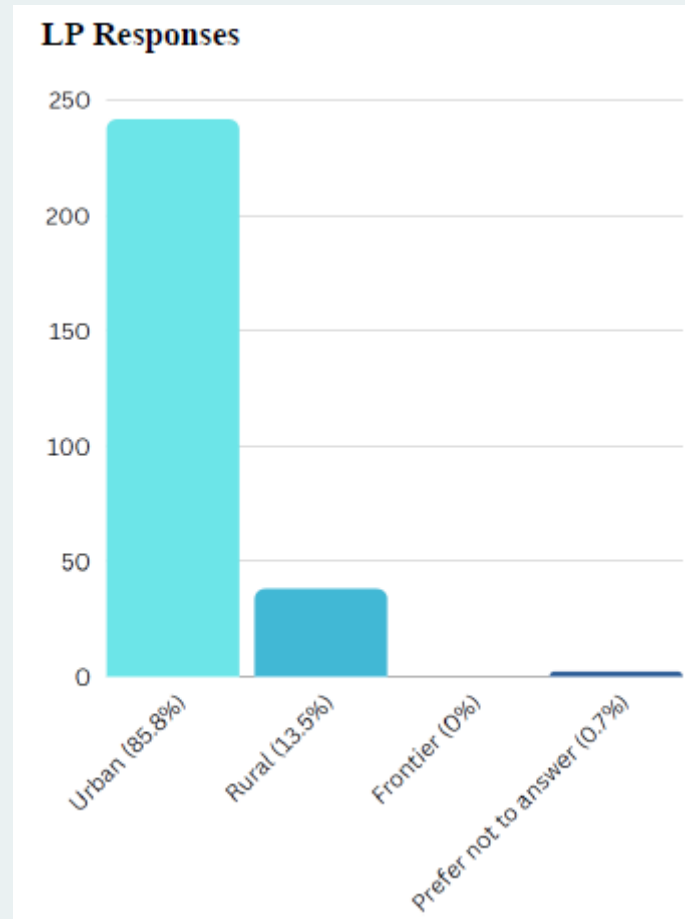
# Survey Response Rates

- Master's Level Psychology
  - Overall - 236 licensees completed the survey (37.7%)
  - LMLPs – 113 licensees completed the survey (32.1%)
  - LCPs – 123 licensees completed the survey (44.9%)
- Professional Counseling
  - Overall – 716 licensees completed the survey (26.6%)
  - LPCs – 274 licensees completed the survey (22.7%)
  - LCPCs – 442 licensees completed the survey (29.7%)

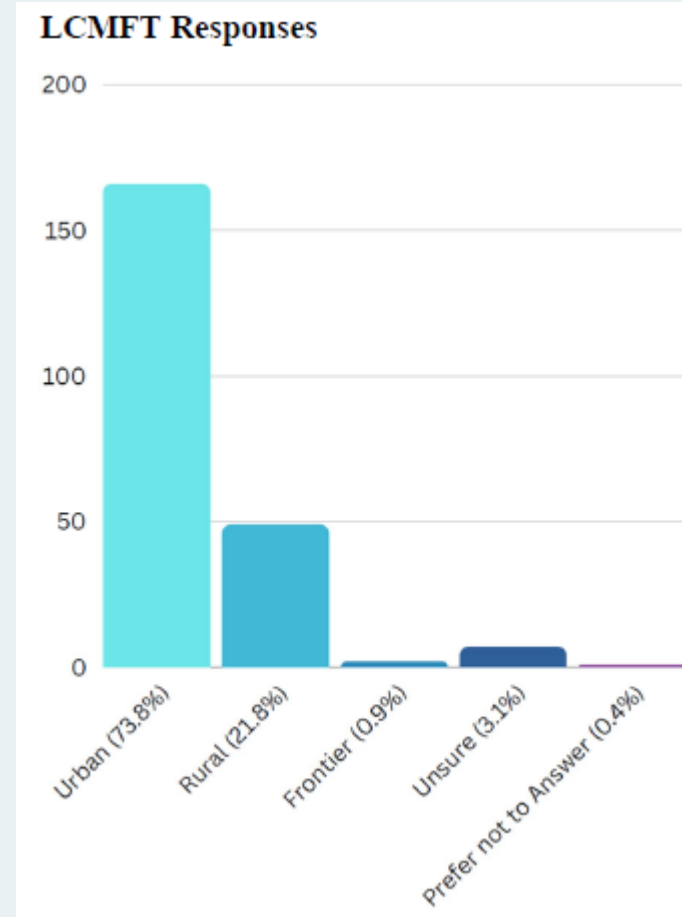
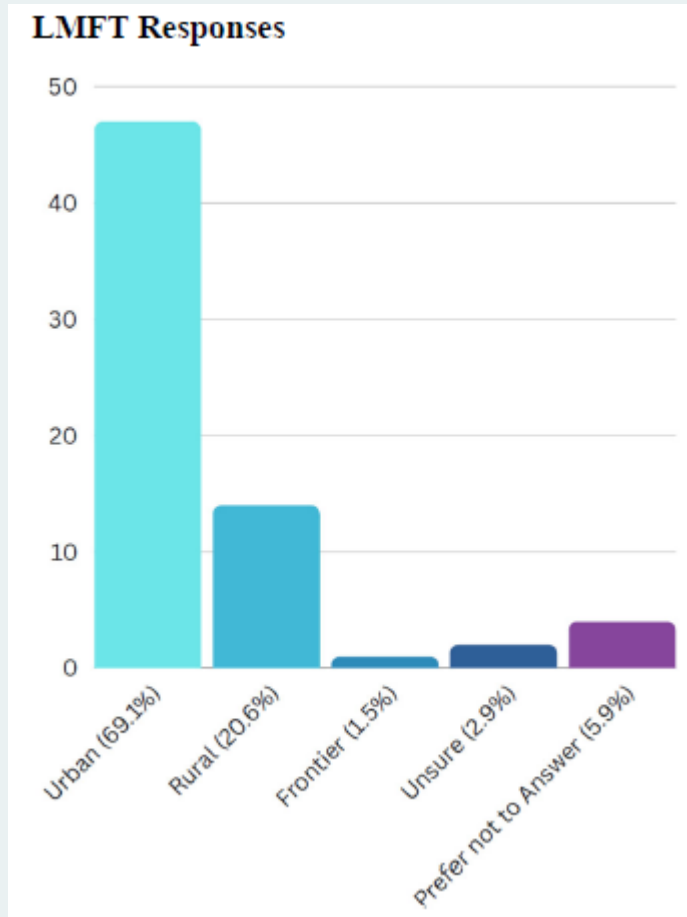
# Survey Response Rates

- Behavior Analysis
  - Overall - 71 licensees completed the survey (14.0%)
  - LaBAs – 3 licensees completed the survey (16.7%)
  - LBAs – 68 licensees completed the survey (13.9%)
- Addiction Counseling results will be made available after the draft survey report is presented at the Addiction Counseling Advisory Committee meeting on June 3, 2025

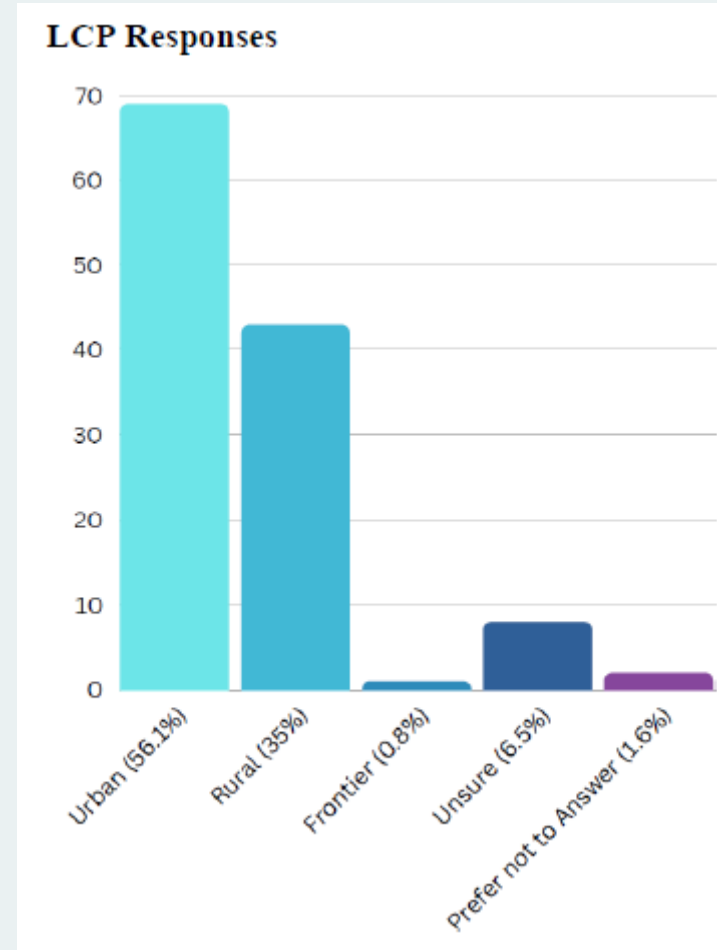
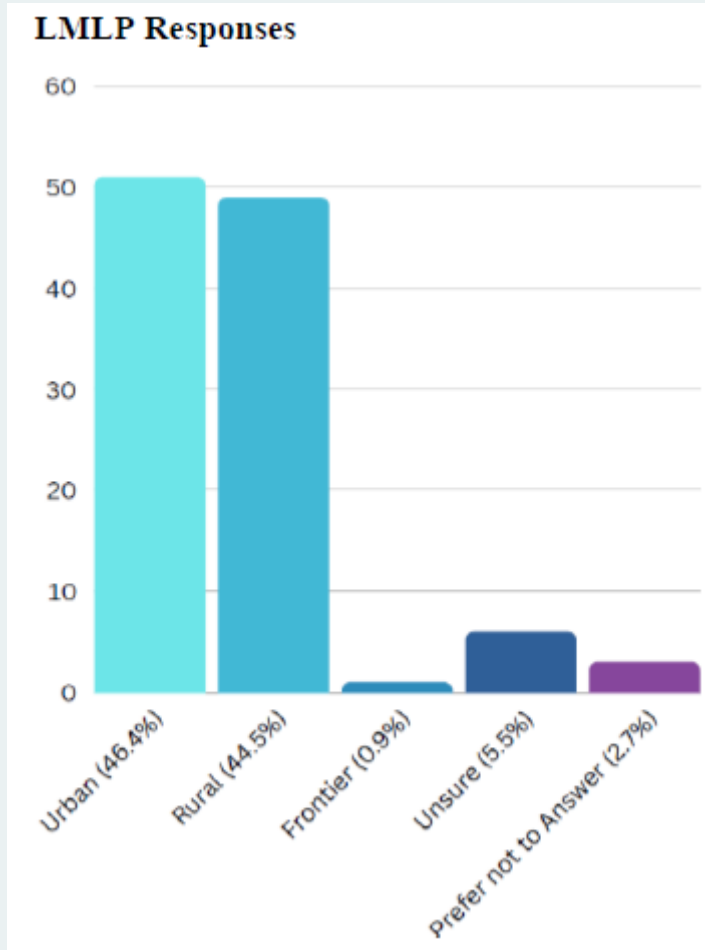

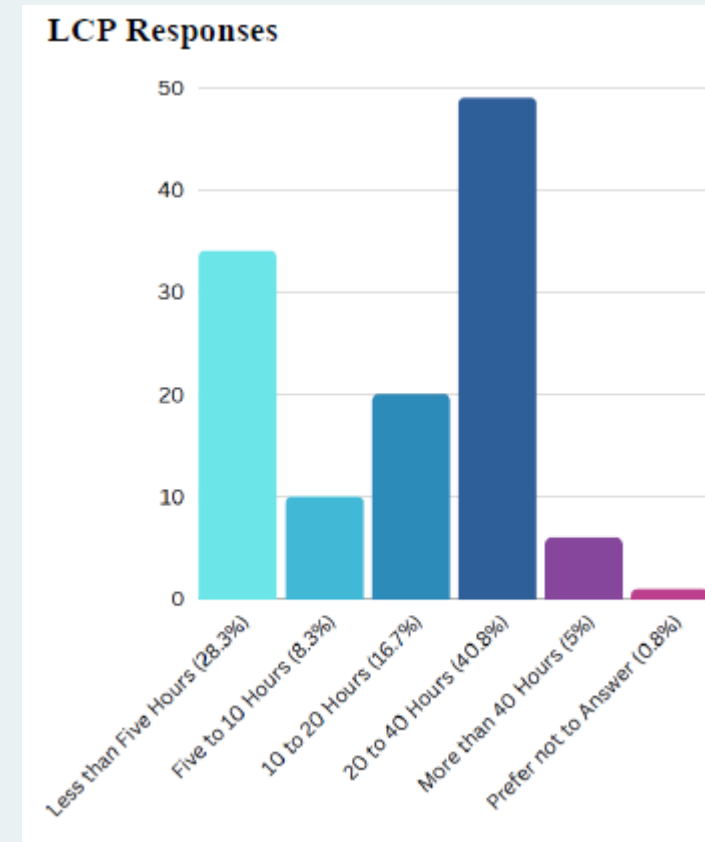
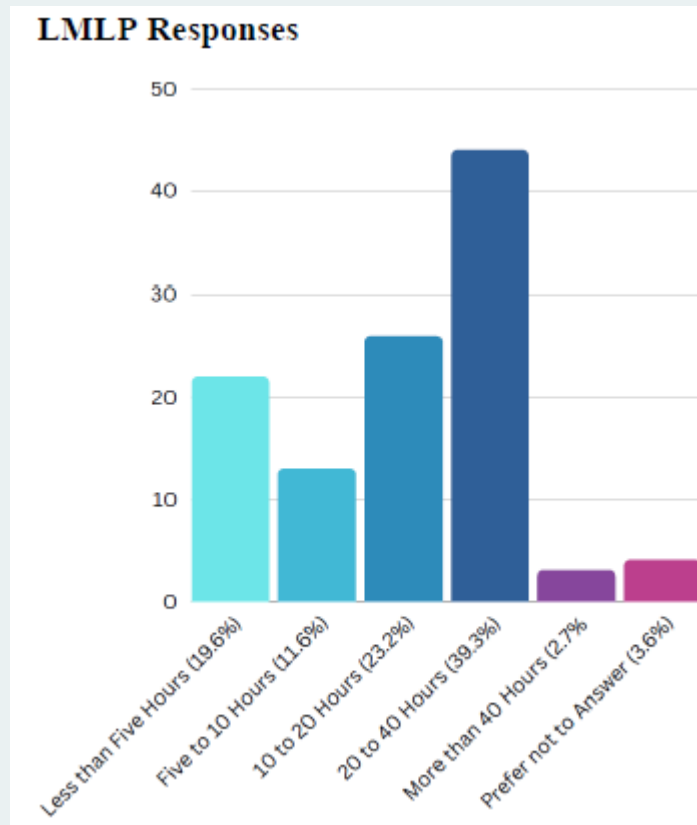
# In a typical week, how many hours do you provide in-person services to clients?



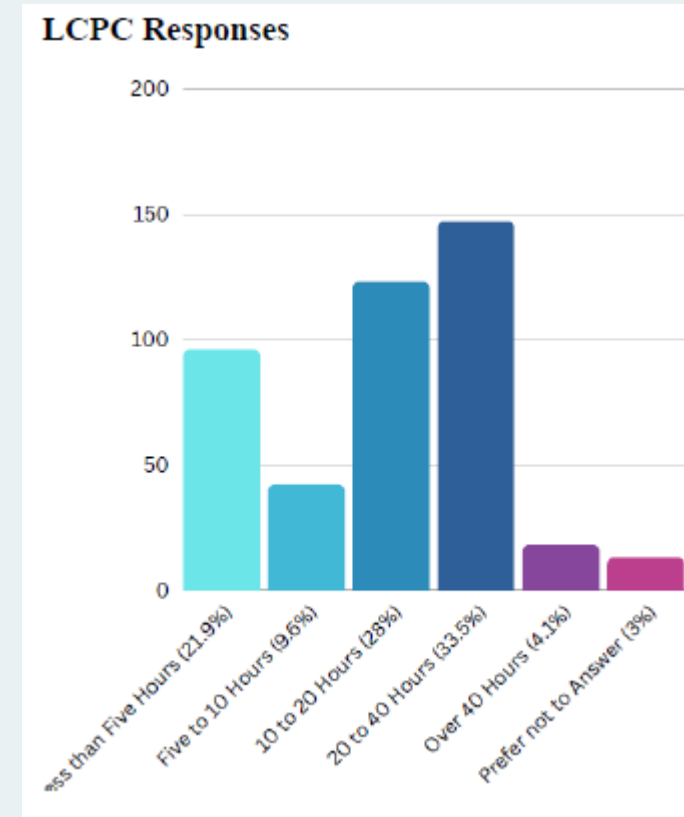
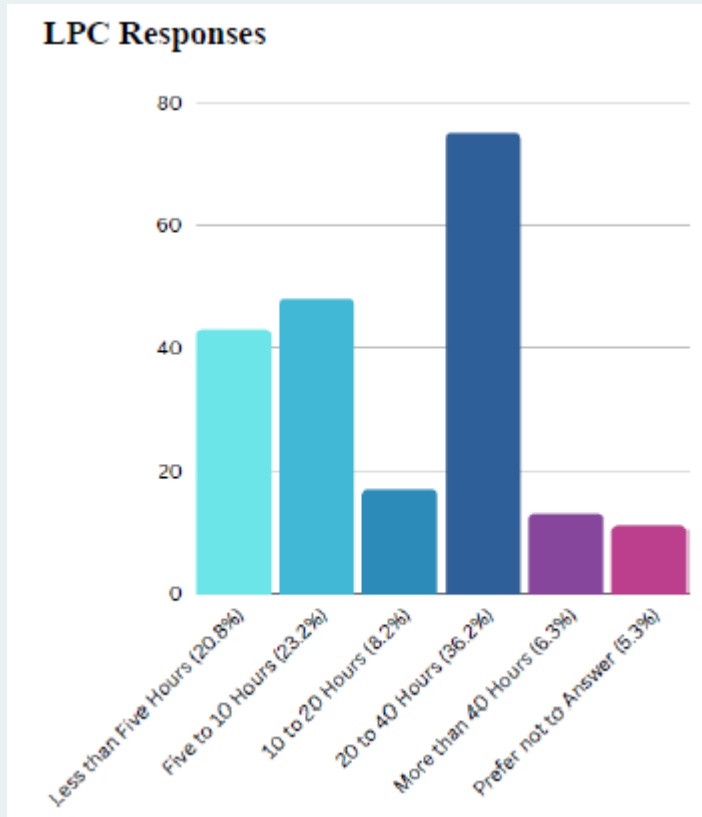

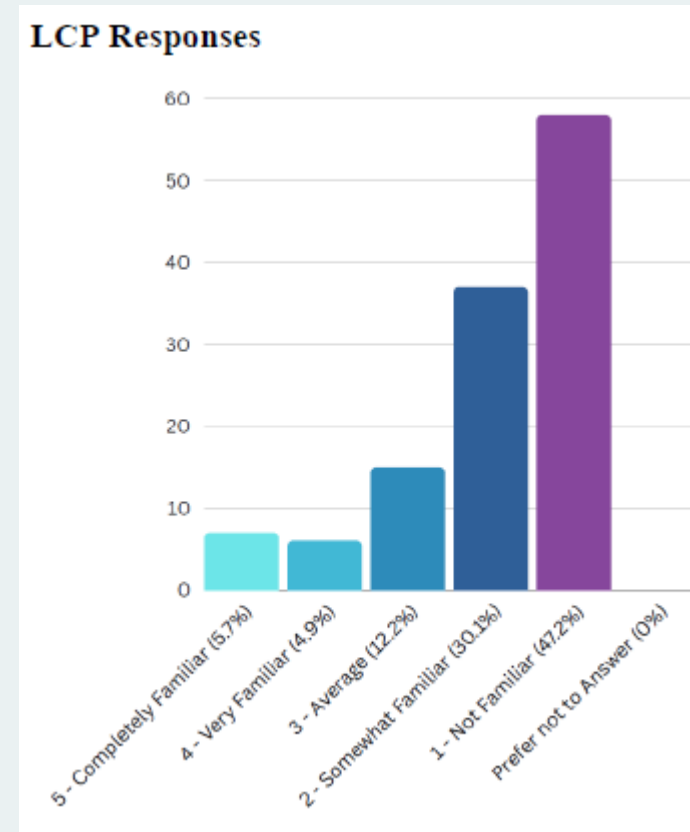
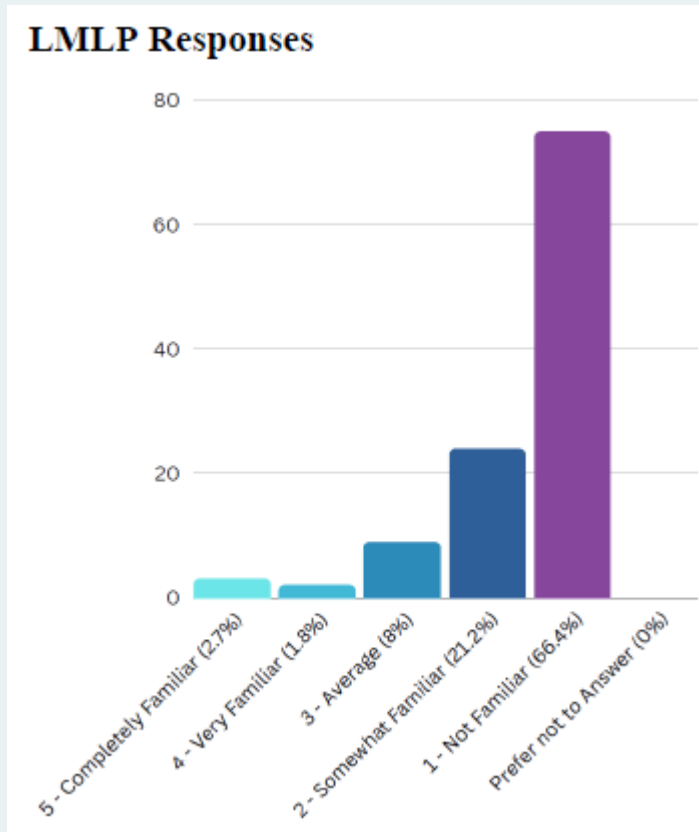
# On a scale of 1 to 5, how familiar are you with the work of the (x) Advisory Committee?



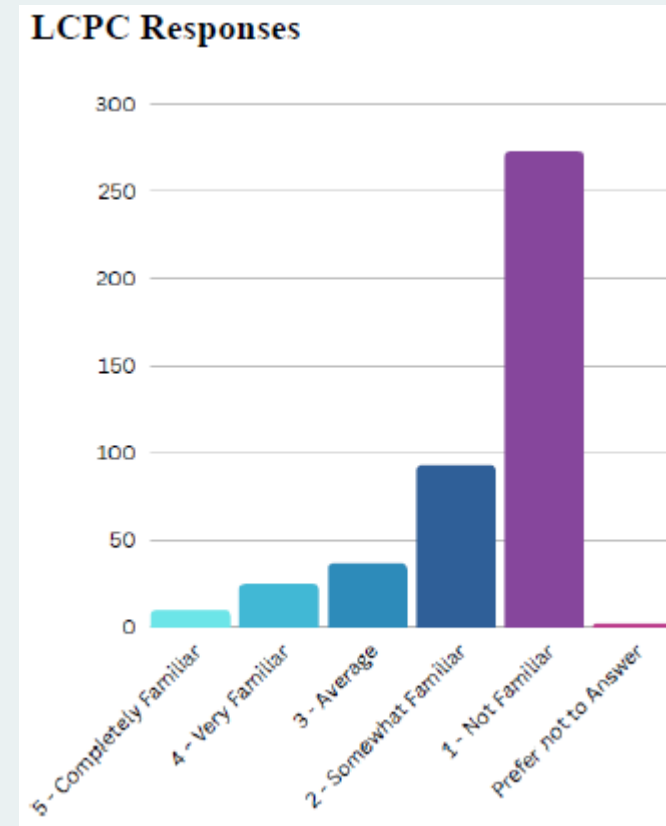
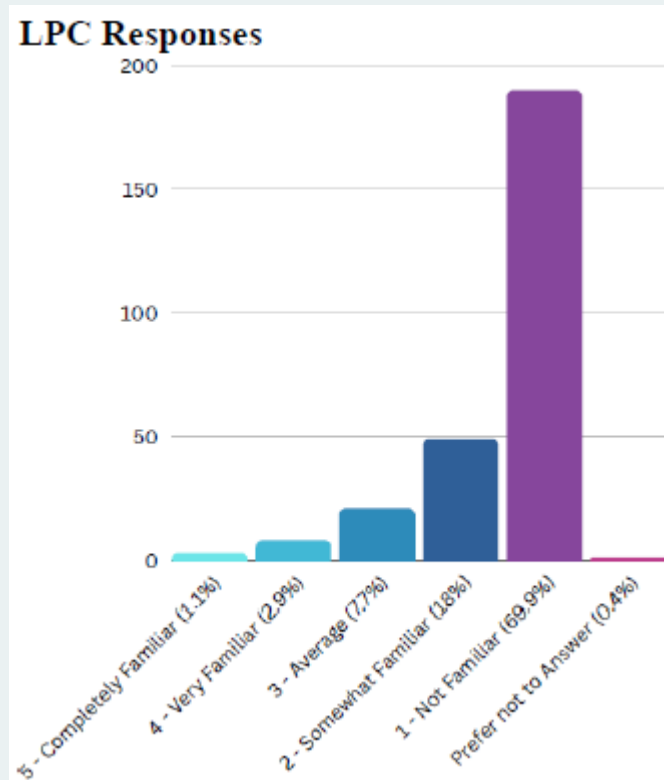
