

FY 2025 Report on Licensing

Original Permanent Licenses Issued – 1,737

During Fiscal Year (FY) 2025, from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, the Kansas Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board (BSRB) issued 1,737 new permanent licenses for seven professions. This is an increase from 1,701 permanent licenses issued in FY 2024 and 1,598 permanent licenses issued in FY 2023.

Method of Issuing Permanent License – Of the 1,737 Permanent Licenses Issued:

- 503 permanent licenses issued to applicants meeting reciprocity requirements (29%)
- 1,234 permanent licenses were issued to applicants not licensed in another jurisdiction (71%)
